



Music

Children are provided with a variety of musical opportunities across the school including our weekly Key Stage singing practices. Music lessons follow the Charanga programme. During these lessons, pupils are exposed to a range of styles of music including classical, modern and music from around the world. The units of work ensure everyone can take part in singing, music making and music appreciation.

Children in Years 3 and 4 receive lessons for playing trumpets or clarinets. They are also given the opportunity to perform to parents.

Each year children are given opportunities to perform outside of school. Children in Y2 participate in an annual singing morning with local schools; Y6 pupils visit a local church and residential care home to sing Christmas carols and a choir formed of KS2 pupils join other Leo schools to perform at an annual evening concert.

For the last two years we have joined thousands of schools across the country to become part of the Young Voices choir who perform at the O2.
